£500,000 DISTRIBUTED TO LOCAL CHARITIES

Chelmsford Silver Gems Majorettes are among the latest voluntary and community groups to benefit from the Grassroots Grants programme. The group received £3,205 to buy leotards and equipment for their members to enable them to take part in national competitions.

Since it was launched in August, over £500,000 has been distributed from the Grassroots Grants programme to 133 voluntary and community groups working in Essex, Southend and Thurrock.

Local grantmaking trust, Essex Community Foundation is managing the Grassroots programme which is a Government initiative funded by the Office of the Third Sector to support community-based projects meeting local needs across Essex. Commenting on the amount distributed so far, Caroline Taylor, Programmes Director at Essex Community Foundation said, "We are really pleased with the response from voluntary groups in applying for grants from this fund programme. We are increasingly told that the application process is simple and groups really appreciate the quick turnaround."

The Grassroots Grants programme is open to any voluntary and community group in Essex, Southend and Thurrock, which is predominately volunteer-led and has an income of under £20,000 per annum. To discuss an application call the Foundation's grants team on 01245 356018.

As well as the Grants programme, the Foundation has been set a Challenge to raise £3.3 million in endowed funding and draw down matched funding of £1.65 million. The Foundation is therefore appealing to all companies and individuals to support their appeal and take advantage of this Government initiative which enables them to uplift donations by at least 50%. At the end of the programme, the invested £5 million fund will give a permanent source of funding to support voluntary and community groups in Essex, Southend and Thurrock.

Grassroots Grants

Grassroots Grants, funded by Office of the Third Sector (OTS) and administered by the Community Development Foundation (CDF), recognises the vital contribution these 'grassroots groups' make to improving our communities.

Over three years, Grassroots Grants will support the sector in building stronger, more active communities with two complementary approaches. An £80 million grants programme will make small grants available to grassroots groups across England. An innovative £50 million endowments match challenge will enable local funders to raise donations on a matched basis and invest them to sustain grassroots funding into the future.
